Please mark your calendars accordingly.




With prayer and conversation, our first Bed Build for Greensburg UMC will be Saturday, May 21. There will be 5 beds made to be given out to children in our community and 15 beds given out to struggling families in Canton who currently do not have beds that weekend. Here is how you can participate.



- Pray: for the ministry, volunteers, resources, and recipients. God does wonders!
- Bring in your donation board for things you can contribute to the beds.
- \$1000 is needed to be raised to create 10 beds. You can donate financially toward the Bed Build (Checks made to Greensburg UMC, note: Bed Brigade or you can make a donation through VANCO online)
- Come to the Gym on May 21. You do NOT need to know about power tools or how to put them together. You are simply
 needed to come and support through packaging bedding together or designing the head boards or praying or volunteering to drop off a bed to a family. And, yes, we will need persons to put beds together and get the system going. All ages
 welcome and needed.

July 31—August 4 @ 6-8 PM | Ages 3—6th Grade


We are going to celebrate God's greatness through awesome Bible-learning experiences kids see, hear, and touch!
